Although not directly equivalent to WVU's ACCT 201 & ACCT 202, ACC 155 & ACC 156 will satisfy the Financial and Managerial Accounting requirements.

To be admitted to the John Chambers College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall 2.25 GPA. Students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C- or better:

- ACC 155 & ACC 156
- ECN 255 & ECN 256
- ENG 161 & ENG 164

- BUS 250 & BUS 244
- BCOR 121 (WVU)

Students completing the above articulated plan of study may choose to enroll in any of the following Chambers College of Business and Economics programs: Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship & Innovation; Finance; General Business; Hospitality and Tourism Management; Human Resource Management; Management Information Systems; Marketing; or Supply Chain Management.

Additional criteria for admissions must also be met for specific programs, see below course or equivalent course requirements:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACC 155 & ACC 156; A minimum grade of D- in BUS 250.
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECN 255 & ECN 256; A minimum grade of C- in BUS 250.
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: minimum grade of D- in BUS 250.
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in ECN 255 & ECN 256; A minimum grade of C- in BUS 250.
- General Business: minimum grade of D- in BUS 250.
- Hospitality and Tourism Management: Minimum grade of D- in BUS 250.
- Human Resource Management: minimum grade of D- in BUS 250.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of C- in BUS 250.
- Marketing: minimum grade of D- in BUS 250.
- Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of C- in BUS 250.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
