***ARE 491's summer internship is one of three options available to complete the Agribusiness Management Capstone requirement. Although it is the most pursued option, students may forgo this summer session and complete the requirement via study abroad or thesis composition. Students are encouraged to work with their advisor to select the option that best suits their academic needs and interests.

ACC 205 (WVU's ACCT 202) has been approved to be utilized as a Restricted Elective.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU. However, with this being an Associates of Applied Science, students must complete all outstanding GEFs prior to graduations.
