**Pending on WVNCC offerings, students should aim to take SOC 126 (WVU SOC 207) and SOC 255 (WVU SOC 221) to complete the lower-level Sociology requirement prior to starting at WVU.

Student must complete SOC 101 with a minimum of C- to be admitted to the Sociology major at WVU. A minimum GPA of 2.0 is required across all courses counted toward meeting Sociology Major Requirements. A minimum grade of C- is required in ANTH 105 and SOC 101.

Students completing degrees in WVU's Eberly College of Arts and Sciences are encouraged to work with their advisors to integrate completion of an academic minor or minors into their programs of study, to the degree allowed within elective hours. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills. WVNCC students may begin completion of certain minors at WVNCC by utilizing *Elective* hours to take courses equivalent to the minor's introductory requirements at WVU.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
