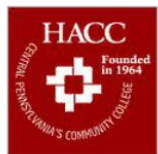

Students who maintain a 2.0 GPA will be directly admitted into the Advertising and Public Relations (ADPR) program upon transferring to West Virginia University. Those students who have below a 2.0 GPA must have a C- or better in COMM 221 (MDIA 215S) to be admitted into the ADPR program within the College of Creative Arts and Media upon transferring.

*Students are required to complete STAT 111 as a HACC requirement. Students who complete MATH 202 at HACC, will have completed the WVU equivalent of STAT 211, therefore, the STAT 111 requirement will be fulfilled as well as the Math Requirement at WVU. The student will need to complete an elective to meet the 120-hour WVU requirement.


ADPR majors are required to declare a minor. Students should work with their faculty advisor to complete this task.
