Students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.25 in all college coursework attempted, and a C- or better in MATH 121 (WVU MATH 155), CAD 154 (WVU ENGR 101), and ENGR 102 (WVU ENGR 191) to be admitted directly to the Electrical Engineering, program at the Statler College of Engineering and Mineral Resources upon transferring to West Virginia University to ensure this pathway.

*Students will need to take EE 221 & EE 221L and EE 223 & EE 223L at WVU in the summer after their second year at Harrisburg Area Community College. Students will need to work with their faculty advisors to stay up to date on offerings and availability.


Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
