Depending on the student's selection to complete the "Literature" and "Literature/Humanities/Fine Arts" requirement(s), the course may satisfy one of the identified programmatic requirements. Students are encouraged to consult with advisors within the WVU English Department or the Eberly College Undergraduate Affairs Office. Any completed requirements would be replaced by General Elective hours to meet.

Students will need to select an Areas of Emphasis (AoE) while at WVU. Students can select from the following:

- Creative Writing
- Literary and Cultural Studies
- Professional Writing and Editing (PWE)

\*\*Students need to choose 2 of the 4 listed literature options to satisfy the English program's Historical Breadth requirement:

- ENGL 2201 = ENGL 261
- ENGL 2202 = ENGL 262
- Visual and performing art options: (see advisor for additional options)
  - PHIL 1101 = PHIL 100
  - PHIL 1130 = PHIL 130
  - HUM 1270 = RELG 102

• ENGL 2276 = ENGL 285 (Multicultural option)\*\*\*\*

\*\*\*\*Student who opt to take ENGL 2276 (ENGL 285) will need to only take the 300+level Multicultural option at WVU. Students must have a GPA of 2.0 in all ENGL courses to be admitted to the English program upon transferring to West Virginia University.

Students completing degrees in WVU's Eberly College of Arts and Sciences are encouraged to work with their advisors to integrate completion of an academic minor or minors into their programs of study, to the degree allowed within elective hours. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills.
