^^Students will need to complete BIOL 117 & BIOL 117L to complete the Biology sequence required for all BS majors. BIOL 101 & BIOL 102 (BIOL 101/L-102/L = BIOL 115 & BIOL 115L)

Students are required to complete MATH 121 (MATH 155) in pursuit of a Psychology BS degree. Students must complete a minimum of 21-credit of science courses.


Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
