Students must complete both COMM 201 and COMM 203 with a grade of C- or better before selecting one of five areas of emphasis in Communication Studies in consultation with their adviser. Obtain a minimum GPA of 2.0 for all required COMM courses used to meet major requirements.

Students are limited to complete 42-credits in their declared major. Example: COMM students may only complete 42-credits within their COMM discipline and have them count towards their required 120-credits for graduation.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
