Students who maintain a 2.0 GPA will be directly admitted into the Advertising and Public Relations (ADPR) program upon transferring to West Virginia University. Those students who have below a 2.0 GPA must have a C- or better in MDIA 215S to be admitted into the ADPR program within the College of Creative Arts and Media upon transferring.

MDIA 215S is not always offered during the summer session. The student should work with their faculty advisor to appropriately schedule the course in the summer before the first full semester or their first fall semester.

ADPR majors are required to declare a minor that will cover the nine credits of Focus coursework. Students should work with their faculty advisor to complete this task.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
