Students must have a 2.0 GPA in HIS courses in order to be admitted directly into the History program upon transferring to West Virginia University.

Students are required to complete proficiency of four semesters worth of the same foreign language to fulfill the Bachelor of Arts requirements at WVU. It is recommended that students begin this requirement at Columbus State Community College through successful completion of Foreign Language courses at the 1101 and 1102 levels. Students who choose not to do so or wish to complete a foreign language not offered at CSCC, will need to utilize *Elective* credit at WVU to do so.

Columbus State students may begin completion of certain minors at CSCC by utilizing Elective hours to take courses equivalent to the minor's introductory requirements at WVU.
