Students who maintain a 2.0 GPA will be directly admitted into the Advertising and Public Relations (ADPR) program upon transferring to West Virginia University. Those students who have below a 2.0 GPA must have a C- or better in COMM 2300 (MDIA 215) to be admitted into the ADPR program within the Reed College of Media upon transferring.

*Students are required to complete STAT 111 as a College of Media requirement. Students who complete STAT 1350 or STAT 1450 at CSCC, will have completed the WVU equivalent of STAT 211/215, therefore, the STAT 111 requirement will be fulfilled as well as the Math Requirement at WVU. The student will need to complete an elective in order to meet the 120-hour WVU requirement.

ADPR majors are required to declare a minor. Students should work with their faculty advisor to complete this task.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
