^^Depending on the selection on Humanities Core course at WVNCC, students will need to complete either a GEF 5 or GEF 6 during their time at WVU. Students can work with their WVU advisor to make their remaining course selections.

\*Students only need to complete either MATH 150 (WVU) or WVNCC MATH 279 (MATH 155 WVU), to satisfy The John Chambers College of Business and Economics Math requirement. Students not able to enter directly into WVNCC MATH 279 (MATH 155 WVU), will need to plan to take MATH 150 during the summer prior to their first fall at WVU.

#Although ENG 101 & 102 are not equivalent to West Virginia University's ENGL 101 & 102, they will be accepted by the College of Business and Economics to satisfy the GEF 1 requirement per the WV HEPC Core Coursework Agreement.

##Although CIT 117 is not a direct equivalent to WVU's CS 101, the Chambers College of Business and Economics will utilize as a substitute for BCOR 121.

\*\*\*Students are encouraged to select a Science Core course that is on the WV HEPC Core Coursework Agreement to satisfy WVU's GEF 2B course requirement.

Students completing this proposed pathway may choose to major within one of the following Chambers College of Business and Economics fields: Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship & Innovation; Finance; General Business; Global Supply Chain Management; Hospitality & Tourism; Integrated Marketing Communication; Management; Management Information Systems; or Marketing; Organizational Leadership. To be admitted to the Chambers College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. To be directly admitted to their desired major, students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C or better:

- CIT 117
- ECON 104 & 105
- MATH 279 or MATH 150 (WVU)
- ENG 101 & 102
- ACC 123 & 205
- MATH 210

Certain degree pathways have additional requirements for admittance:

Accounting requires:

- B- or higher in both ACC 123 & 205.
- A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150 (WVU) or a grade of D- in MATH 279.

Economics requires:

- One B- or higher and one C- or higher in ECON 104 & 105.
- B- or higher in MATH 150 (WVU) or a grade of C- in MATH 279.

Entrepreneurship and Innovation:

- D- or higher MATH 150 (WVU) or a grade of D- in MATH 279.

Finance requires:

- B- or higher in both ECON 104 & 105.
- B- or higher MATH 150 (WVU) or a grade of C- in MATH 279.

Global Supply Chain Management

- B- or higher in MATH 150 (WVU) or a grade of C- in MATH 279.

General Business

- D- or higher MATH 150 (WVU) or a grade of D- in MATH 279.

Hospitality & Tourism

- D- or higher MATH 150 (WVU) or a grade of D- in MATH 279.

Management

- C- or higher in MATH 150 (WVU) or a grade of D- in MATH 279.

Management Information System requires:

- B- or higher in MATH 150 (WVU) or a grade of C- in MATH 279.

Marketing:

- C- or higher in MATH 150 (WVU) or a grade of D- in MATH 279.

Organizational Leadership

- C- or higher in MATH 150 (WVU) or a grade of D- in MATH 279.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU. However, with this being an Associates of Applied Science, students must complete all outstanding GEFs prior to graduations.
