*Although completion of four semesters of Spanish (SPAN 103, 104, 203, & 204) at ACM is not required for graduation from ACM with an AS degree, students are encouraged to utilize the electives within their first 4 semesters to take these courses, which will complete WVU's Eberly College Bachelor of Arts language requirement. Doing so will provide 12 additional elective credit hours in the 3rd and 4th years, and allow more flexibility within a student's time at WVU to explore opportunities such as internships, study abroad, etc. Graduation on a 4-year time frame is still possible for those students who wish to study a language different from Spanish or wish to complete the foreign language requirement at WVU.

Students must have a 2.0 GPA in HIS courses to be admitted directly into the History program upon transferring to West Virginia University.

Students pursuing a degree in History at WVU are required to complete a double major, formal minor, or informal minor. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills. Allegany College students may begin completion of certain minors at ACM by utilizing elective hours to take courses equivalent to the minor's introductory requirements at WVU.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
