Students transferring into the Anthropology program at West Virginia University must have a C- or better in SOCI 101 (WVU SOC 101) and complete ANTH 105 in their first term at WVU.

A minimum GPA of a 2.0 is required in all courses applied to major requirements, with a minimum grade of C- required in SOC 101 (SOCI 101), ANTH 105, ANTH 259, ANTH 359. SOC 101, ANTH 105, ANTH 259, ANTH 359.

Students completing degrees in WVU's Eberly College of Arts and Sciences are encouraged to work with their advisors to integrate completion of an academic minor or minors into their programs of study, to the degree allowed within elective hours. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills.

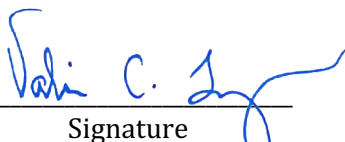
Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
