To be admitted to the English program, student must have a 2.0 GPA in all ENGL classes taken, and a 2.0 overall GPA. The department will accept students with an overall GPA below a 2.00 if it is the result of low grades outside of the Humanities.

\*Students should consider beginning or completing Foreign Language at CCAC using their Humanities and Major Field Electives slots. Doing so would provide great flexibility at WVU for course selection. If completed students can exchange their Foreign Language course for General Electives.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.

Students completing degrees in WVU's Eberly College of Arts and Sciences are encouraged to work with their advisors to integrate completion of an academic minor or minors into their programs of study, to the degree allowed within elective hours. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills. See
