Students must have a 2.0 GPA in HIS courses to be admitted directly into the History program upon transferring to West Virginia University.

*Student who selects from the following: HIST 212 or HIST 213 or HIST 214 or HIST 215 or HIST 217 or HIST 220 or HIST 221, can apply their selections to the U.S. Region Course requirement. Students who select HIST 221 (HIST 360) will complete a 300/400-level course requirement.

Students will have the option to select from several regions and courses to complete their History Concentration. Students must complete at least one course in all three of the following regions, with twelve of the total 18 hours at the 300 or 400 level.

- Take one History course in each geographical concentration area:
 - US, Europe, and Africa/ Asia/ Latin America
- Take three (3) additional History courses (no geographical req).
- 18 total credits-of which 12 credits must be at the 300/400 level.


Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
