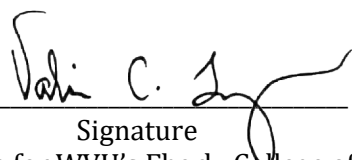
Students are highly encouraged to follow the recommendations noted on the transfer agreement for Psychology course selection to avoid issues upon transfer.
