For this agreement:

- CIS 105 will satisfy the requirement for BCOR 121.
- *ACCT 150, ACCT 151, ACCT 160 & ACCT 161 will satisfy the requirement of ACCT 201 & ACCT 202 although not directly equivalent.

**Students need to complete only MATH 103 (MATH 126 WVU) for some majors in the Chambers College of Business and Economics. Students will need to complete MATH 110 (MATH 150 WVU) with a C- or higher only if pursuing one of these majors: Applied AI and Data Analytics, Economics, Finance, Supply Chain Management, and Management Information Systems.

To be admitted to the College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. Students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C- or better:

- ACCT 150, ACCT 151, ACCT 160 & ACCT 161
- ECON 201 & ECON 202
- ENGL 101 & ENGL 102
- MATH 103 & MATH 202
- CIS 105

Students completing this proposed pathway may choose to major within one of the following Chambers College of Business and Economics fields: Accounting; Applied AI and Data Analytics; Economics; Entrepreneurship and Innovation; Finance; General Business; Hospitality & Tourism; Human Resource Management; Management Information Systems; Marketing; or Supply Chain Management.

Applied AI and Data Analytics requires only BCOR 330 once students are enrolled at WVU. Academic advisors will create this plan of study.

Depending upon the student's choice of major, additional criteria for admissions must also be met:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACCT 150, ACCT 151, ACCT 160 & ACCT 161; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 103
- Applied AI and Data Analytics: A minimum grade of C- in MATH 110.
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECON 201 and ECON 202; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 110.
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: minimum grade of C- in MATH 103.
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in ECON 201 & ECON 202; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 110.
- General Business: minimum grade of C- in MATH 103.
- Hospitality & Tourism: minimum grade of C- in MATH 103.
- Human Resource Management: minimum grade of C- in MATH 103.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of C- in MATH 110.
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MATH 103.
- Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of C- in MATH 110.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
