Although not directly equivalent to WVU's ACCT 201 and ACCT 202, ACC 210 and ACC 213 will be utilized to fulfill the Financial and Managerial Accounting requirements.

Students must take the equivalent to WVU's ENGL 101 (ENG 101) to satisfy the prerequisites requirement for BCOR 299.

\*Though MATH 150 is listed prior to the beginning of the third year, Garrett students may take it online through WVU at any time. It is recommended to be taken the summer following completion of MAT 105 (WVU's MATH 124). Students who can place into MAT 190 (MATH 155) at Garrett should attempt to complete the requirement prior to transferring to WVU.

Students need to complete only MAT 105 (MATH 124) for some majors in the Chambers College of Business and Economics. Students will need to complete MAT 190 (MATH 155) with a D- or higher only if pursuing one of these majors: Applied AI and Data Analytics; Economics, Finance, Supply Chain Management, and Management Information Systems. See Below for all requirements.

^To be admitted to the Chambers College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. Students must also complete the following Chambers College of Business and Economics' prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C- or better:

- ACC 210 & ACC 213
- ECN 201 & ECN 202
- ENG 101 & ENG 102

- MAT 105 & MAT 210
- CIS 105

Students completing this proposed pathway may choose to major within one of the following Chambers College of Business and Economics s fields: Accounting; Applied AI and Data Analytics; Economics; Entrepreneurship and Innovation; Finance; General Business; Supply Chain Management; Hospitality and Tourism Management; Human Resource Management; Management Information Systems; Marketing.

Depending upon the student's choice of major, additional criteria for admissions must also be met:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACC 210 & ACC 213; A minimum grade of C- in MAT 105.
- Applied AI and Data Analytics: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150 (WVU) or D- in MAT 190.
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECN 201 & ECN 202; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150 (WVU) or D- in MAT 190.
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: minimum grade of C- in MAT 105.
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in ECN 201 & 202; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150 (WVU) or D- in MAT 190.
- General Business: minimum grade of C- in MAT 105.
- Hospitality and Tourism Management: minimum grade of C- in MAT 105.
- Human Resource Management: minimum grade of C- in MAT 105.
- Management Information System: A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150 (WVU) or D- in MAT 190.
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MAT 105.

• Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150 (WVU) or D- in MAT 190.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
