\*Students who complete HIST 205 (WVU HIST 250) will satisfy their lower-level United States region course. Students who wish to complete another course can opt to select from any BVCTC course and replace a General Elective at WVU with a United States course option.

Students must have a 2.0 GPA in HIST courses to be admitted directly into the History program upon transferring to West Virginia University. Students must earn a minimum GPA of 2.0 with no grade lower than a C- in all courses applied to the History Major.

Students will have the option to select from several regions and courses to complete their History Concentration. Students must complete at least one course in all three of the following regions, with twelve of the total 18 hours at the 300 or 400 level.

- Take one History course in each geographical concentration area:
  - US, Europe, and Africa/ Asia/ Latin America
- Take three (3) additional History courses (no geographical req).
- 18 total credits-of which 12 credits must be at the 300/400 level.

Students pursuing a degree in History from West Virginia University are required to complete an academic minor.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.


