Students completing this proposed pathway may choose to major within one of the following Chambers College of Business and Economics fields: Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship and Innovation; Finance; General Business; Global Supply Chain Management; Hospitality \& Tourism; Integrated Marketing Communication; Management; Management Information Systems; or Marketing; Organizational Leadership.

To be admitted to the Chambers College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. Students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C or better:

- ACCT 101 \& ACCT 102
- MATH 212 \& MATH 216
- BA 210
- ENG 101 \& ENG 109
- ECON 101 \& ECON 102

Depending upon the student's choice of major, additional criteria for admissions must also be met:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACCT 101 \& 102; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 212.
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECON 101 and 102; a grade of B- or higher in
- MATH 212.
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in ECON 101 \& ECON 102; a grade of B- in MATH 212.
- General Business: minimum grade of D- in MATH 212.
- Global Supply Chain Management: B- or higher in MATH 212.
- Hospitality \& Tourism: minimum grade of D- in MATH 212.
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: minimum grade of D- in MATH 212.
- Management: minimum grade of C- in MATH 212.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of B- in MATH 212.
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MATH 212.
- Organizational Leadership: minimum grade of C- in MATH 212.

Business Administration B.S.B.AD. Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
