To be admitted to the John Chambers College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. Students must also complete the following Chambers College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C- or better:

- ACC 121 & ACC 240
- ECN 201 & ECN 202
- ENG 101 & ENG 102

- CIS 114
- MTH 225 & MTH 135 and
 MATH 150 (WVU depending upon major.)

Students completing the above articulated plan of study may choose to enroll in any of the following Chambers College of Business & Economics programs: Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship & Innovation; Finance; General Business; Supply Chain Management; Human Resource Management; Management Information Systems; Marketing.

The following majors require ACC 240 (ACCT 202):

Accounting

Finance

Depending upon the student's choice of major, additional criteria for admissions must also be met:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACC 121 & ACC 240; A minimum grade of C- in MTH 135
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECN 201 and ECN 202; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in ECN 201 & ECN 202; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- General Business: minimum grade of C- in MTH 135.
- Hospitality & Tourism: minimum grade of C- in MTH 135.
- Human Resource Management: minimum grade of C- in MTH 135.
- Entrepreneurship & Innovation: minimum grade of C- in MTH 135.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MTH 135.
- Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.

^{*}Students need to complete only MTH 135 (MATH 126 WVU) for some majors in the Chambers College of Business and Economics. Students will need to complete MTH 150 (WVU) only if pursuing one of these majors: Economics, Finance, Supply Chain Management, and Management Information Systems.
