**IPEDS Degree Level Definitions
Implemented by HEPC in Fall 2009**

Doctoral Degree-Research/Scholarship: A Ph.D. or other doctoral degree that requires advanced work beyond the master's level including the preparation and defense of a dissertation based on original research or the planning and execution of an original project demonstrating substantial artistic or scholarly achievement. Examples at WVU include, but are not limited to, the PhD, DMA, and DNS.

Doctoral Degree-Professional Practice: A program of advanced work beyond the master's level providing the knowledge and skills for the recognition, credential, or license required for professional practice. Examples at WVU include, but are not limited to, the EdD, JD, DDS, MD, PharmD, DNP, DPT, and AuD.

Doctoral Degree-Other: A doctoral degree that does not meet the definition of a Doctoral Degree-Research/Scholarship or Doctoral Degree-Professional Practice

Master's Degree: An award that requires the successful completion of a program of study of generally one or two full-time equivalent academic years of work beyond the bachelor's degree.

Designation of degree classifications are determined by the awarding institution.

In addition, the historic first-professional certificate award category have been eliminated. Any certificates previously counted in this category will be captured in the post-master's certificate category.
