
Students transferring from another institution must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.0 and a 2.0 in Communication Studies courses or have taken at least one COMM course with a minimum grade of C-.

Students are limited to complete 42-credits in their declared major. Example: COMM students may only complete 42-credits within their COMM discipline and have them count towards their required 120-credits for graduation.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
