Although not directly equivalent, students completing ATEC 115 (CS 1TC) will have satisfied the requirement for BCOR 121.

Students must take a MATH 124 or higher equivalent (BVCTC's MATH 125 or MATH 130) to enroll in both MATH 150 and STAT 211 at WVU. STAT 211 is required for all majors within the Chamber College of Business and Economics. Students will need to enroll in MATH 150 if they plan to pursue the following programs: Finance; Management Information Systems; Supply Chain Management; Economics.

Although not directly equivalent, ACCT 215 and ACCT 216 will be accepted and fulfilled Financial and Managerial Accounting.

Students completing this proposed pathway may choose to major within one of the following College of Business and Economics fields: Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship and Innovation; Finance; General Business; Hospitality & Tourism; Human Resource Management; Management Information Systems; Marketing; or Supply Chain Management.

To be admitted to the College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. Students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C- or better:

- ACCT 215 & ACCT 216
- ECON 202 & ECON 201 (WVU)
- ENGL 101 & ENGL 102

- ATEC 115
- MATH 125 or MATH 130
- STAT 211 or ECON 225 (WVU)

Depending upon the student's choice of major, additional criteria for admissions must also be met:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACCT 215 & ACCT 216; minimum grade of C- in MATH 125 or MATH 130.
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECON 201 & ECON 202; A minimum grade of C-in MATH 150.
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: minimum grade of C- in MATH 125 or MATH 130.
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in ECON 201 and ECON 202; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- General Business: minimum grade of C- in MATH 125 or MATH 130.
- Hospitality & Tourism: minimum grade of C- in MATH 125 or MATH 130.
- Human Resource Management: minimum grade of C- in MATH 125 or MATH 130.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MATH 125 or MATH 130.
- Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or Associate of Applied Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
