Students require a total of 120 hours to be eligible for graduation.

The School of Nursing offers in-state tuition for all students enrolled in the RN-BSN program, regardless of residency. All registered nurses will transfer 50 hours of undifferentiated nursing credit based on RN licensure.

Advisors will work with students to identify courses already appearing on the transcript that meet GEF requirements and develop a plan to fulfill any remaining GEF requirements. RN to BSN general education requirements, regarding of University GEF credit requirements: ENGL 1100/ENGL 1101 (ENGL 101), ENGL 2367/ENGL 2467/ ENGL 2567/ ENGL 2667/ENGL 2767 (ENGL 102), and STAT 1350 (STAT 211)

Students receiving federal financial aid should work with their academic advisor to meet requirements for renewal, which often includes a minimum of twelve degree-pursuant hours.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts, Associate of Applied Science or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
