Please note that some ENGL courses require ENGL 101 and/or 102 as a pre-requisite for registration. Those include ENGL 221, 301, 304, 305, 337, 338, 355, 407, and 408. ENGL 1C1 and 1C2 do not satisfy the pre-requisite in the catalog so students will need to work with an advisor for a permit into these courses.

Students will need to select an Area of Emphasis (12-credits) from the below options:

- Creative Writing
- Literary and Cultural Studies
- Professional Writing and Editing (PWE)

Students must have a 2.0 GPA in all ENG classes to be admitted directly to the English program upon transferring to West Virginia University.

Students completing degrees in WVU's Eberly College of Arts and Sciences are encouraged to work with their advisors to integrate completion of an academic minor or minors into their programs of study, to the degree allowed within elective hours. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills. WVNCC students may begin completion of certain minors at WVNCC by utilizing *Elective* hours to take courses equivalent to the minor's introductory requirements at WVU.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
