Students must have a C- or better in any POL course to be admitted directly to the Political Science program upon transferring to West Virginia University.

*Although completion of four semesters of Spanish (LANG 103, 104, 203, & 204) at ACM is not required for graduation from ACM with an AS degree, students are encouraged to utilize the electives within their first 4 semesters to take these courses. Doing so will complete WVU's Eberly College Bachelor of Arts language requirement. Student's wishing to complete a different foreign language at WVU will be required to exceed the listed hour requirements during their two years at WVU.

**Number of General Electives may vary depending on GEF overlap and Area of Emphasis.

Students completing a degree in Political Science are required to work with their advisors to integrate completion of an academic minor into their program of study. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills. Allegany students may begin completion of certain minors at ACM by utilizing elective hours to take courses equivalent to the minor's introductory requirements at WVU.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.


