Students who can place into BVCTC's MATH 113 (WVU's MATH 121) should attempt to complete Bridge Valley's MATH 130 (or WVU's MATH 124) requirement prior to transferring to WVU.

Students must take a MATH 124 or higher equivalent (BVCTC's MATH 130) to enroll in both MATH 150 and ECON 225 or STAT 211 at WVU. ECON 225 or STAT 211 is required for all majors within the Chamber College of Business and Economics. It is in the best interest of the Bridge Valley students to complete MATH 130/MATH 126 before transferring to WVU.

Though ECON 201 & ECON 202 and ECON 225/STAT 211 are listed prior to the beginning of the third year, Bridge Valley students may also take them online through WVU at any time. It is recommended that ECON 101 or 102 is taken in the summer following completion of their first year.

Although not directly equivalent, students completing ATEC 115 (CS 1TC) will have satisfied the requirement for BCOR 121.

Although not directly equivalent, ACCT 215 and ACCT 216 will be accepted and fulfilled Financial and Managerial Accounting.

To be admitted to the College of Business and Economics students must have an overall GPA of 2.25; to pursue the B.S.B.AD in Accounting,, students must have an overall GPA of 2.5. Students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C or better:

- ACCT 215 & ACCT 216
- ECON 202 & ECON 201 (WVU)
- ENGL 101 & ENGL 102

- MATH 130
- ATEC 115
- STAT 211 or ECON 225(WVU)

Depending upon the student's choice of major, additional criteria for admissions must also be met:

• Accounting: An overall GPA of 2.5; A grade of B- or higher in ACCT 215 & ACCT 216; minimum grade of C- in MATH 130.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science degree, or Associate of Applied Science will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.

Students who have questions regarding this articulation agreement or the transferability of coursework may contact the WVU Office of the University Registrar. All other questions should be directed at the WVU Office of Admissions.
