Although not directly equivalent the John Chambers College of Business and Economics courses the following will be utilized via substitutions:

- AC 201 = ACCT 2TC for ACCT 201
- ACCT 202 = ACCT 2TC for ACCT 202

To be admitted to the Chambers College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall 2.25 GPA. Students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C- or better:

- AC 201 & AC 201
- EC 110 & EC 111
- EN 101 & EN 102
- MA 104 & MATH 112
- BCOR 121 (WVU)

Students completing the above articulated plan of study may choose to enroll in any of the following Chambers College of Business and Economics programs: Accounting; Applied AI and Data Analytics; Economics; Entrepreneurship & Innovation; Finance; General Business; Hospitality and Tourism Management; Human Resource Management; Management Information Systems; Marketing; Supply Chain Management.

Students will only need to complete MATH 104 (MATH 155) with D- or higher to be accepted by any major.

Applied AI and Data Analytics requires only BCOR 330 once students are enrolled at WVU. Academic advisors will create this plan of study.

Additional criteria for admissions must also be met for specific programs, see below course or equivalent course requirements:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in AC 201 & AC 202; A minimum grade of D- in MA 104.
- Applied AI and Data Analytics: A minimum grade of D- in MA 104
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in EC 110 & EC 111; A minimum grade of D- in MA 104
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: minimum grade of D- in MATH 104.
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in EC 110 & EC 111; A minimum grade of D- in MA 104.
- General Business: minimum grade of D- in MA 104.
- Hospitality and Tourism Management: Minimum grade of D- in MA 104.
- Human Resource Management: minimum grade of D- in MA 104.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of D- in MATH 104.
- Marketing: minimum grade of D- in MA 104.
- Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of D- in MA 104.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
