To be admitted to the John Chambers College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. Students must also complete the following Chambers College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C or better:

- ACC 121 & ACC 240
- ECN 201 & ECN 202
- ENG 101 & ENG 102

- CIS 141
- MTH 225 & MATH 150 (WVU)

Students completing the above articulated plan of study may choose to enroll in any of the following Chambers College of Business & Economics programs: Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship & Innovation; Finance; General Business; Global Supply Chain Management; Management; Management Information Systems; Marketing; Organizational Leadership.

The following majors require ACC 240 (ACCT 202):

- Accounting
- Finance

- Global Supply Chain Management
- Management

Depending upon the student's choice of major, additional criteria for admissions must also be met:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACC 121 & ACC 240; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECN 201 and ECN 202; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in ECN 201 & ECN 202; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- General Business: minimum grade of D- in MATH 150.
- Global Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Hospitality & Tourism: minimum grade of D- in MATH 150.
- Entrepreneurship & Innovation: minimum grade of D- in MATH 150.
- Management: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Organizational Leadership: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.

AAS to Business Administration B.S.B.AD.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU. Unlike other Eastern West Virginia pathways, this is an Associate of Applied Science and does not fulfill the GEF requirements. Student will need to complete the missing GEF during their time at WVU.
