Students must have a C- or higher in BIOL 1113, BIO 1114, and CHM 1171 (BIOL 115, BIOL 117, and CHEM 115) in order to be admitted directly into the Biology program upon transferring to West Virginia University.

The 16 hours of upper-division courses can include any 300- or 400-level BIOL course except: BIOL 318, BIOL 327, BIOL 490, BIOL 491, BIOL 494, and above; they must include one class with a lab.

No more than one of the following classes may be counted as a BIOL elective: AEM 341, AEM 401, AGBI 410, BIOC 339, BIOC 531, GEOL 331, PHYS 225.

Students completing degrees from the WVU Eberly College of Arts and Sciences are encouraged to work with their advisors to integrate completion of an academic minor or minors into their programs of study. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills. Columbus State students may begin completion of certain minors at CSCC by utilizing elective hours to take courses equivalent to the minor's introductory requirements at WVU.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
