Students transferring to West Virginia University under this Articulation Agreement will be accepted into the Anthropology program despite lacking the ANTH 105 requirement. Students will need to complete SOC 1101 (WVU SOC 101) with at least a C or higher.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.

**STAT 1350 (WVU STAT 211) or LING 2000 (WVU LING 101) will satisfy the Subfield Enrichment Requirement for Anthropology majors at WVU.

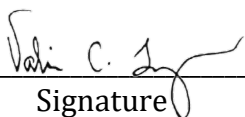
