- ACCT 201 & ACCT 202 (WVU)
- ECON 201 & ECON 202 (WVU)
- EN 161 & EN 162

- MATH 150 & STAT 211 (WVU)
- BCOR 121 (WVU)
- BCOR 299 (WVU)

Students completing the above articulated plan of study may choose to enroll in any of the following Chambers College of Business and Economics programs: Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship & Innovation; Finance; General Business; Global Supply Chain Management; Hospitality and Tourism Management; Management; Management Information Systems; Marketing; Organizational Leadership.

Additional criteria for admissions must also be met for specific programs, see below course or equivalent course requirements:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACCT 201 & ACCT 202; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECON 201 & ECON 202; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: minimum grade of D- in MATH 150.
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in ECON 201 & ECON 202; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- General Business: minimum grade of D- in MATH 150.
- Global Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Hospitality and Tourism Management: A grade of C- or higher in ACCT 201. Minimum grade of D- in MATH 150.
- Management: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Organizational Leadership: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU. However, this pathway is beginning with an Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S) will need to work with their faculty advisor to complete all outstanding General Education Foundation (GEF) courses.
