For this agreement, the following course substitutions are being allowed:

- ECON 202 = ECON 201 – ARE 150
- ACCT 150 & ACCT 151 = ACCT 1TC – ARE 110
- BUSI 201 or BUSI 209 = BTEC 212 – ARE 482
- MGMT 201 = BTEC 101 – ARE 204
- MKTG 201 = BTEC 104 – ARE 431

ACCT 160 & ACCT 161 (WVU’s ACCT 202) and MATH 110 (WVU MATH 150) have been approved to be utilized as a Restricted Elective.

ARE 491’s summer internship is one of three options available to complete the Agribusiness Management Capstone requirement. Although it is the most pursued option, students may forgo this summer session and complete the requirement via study abroad or thesis composition. Students are encouraged to work with their advisor to select the option that best suits their academic needs and interests.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
