Due to the number of English courses required for the Associate of Arts at Harrisburg Area Community College and the number of English courses remaining at West Virginia University, a student will exceed the credit limitation rule of 42-hours in one subject. The student will need to make up six (6) additional hours of non-English courses to graduate. The student will need to work with their faculty advisor to complete this component.

\*Students who complete ENGL 265 (WVU ENGL 285) or ENGL 206 (WVU ENGL 226) or ENGL 217 (WVU ENGL 254) will have completed the program's required 200-level Gender/Multicultural/Transnational course.

Students must a grade of C- or better in all ENGL courses taken to be admitted to the English program at WVU.

Student will need to select an Area of Emphasis (12-credits) from the following:

- Creative Writing
- Literature and Cultural Studies
- Professional Writing and Editing.

Students completing degrees in WVU's Eberly College of Arts and Sciences are encouraged to work with their advisors to integrate completion of an academic minor or minors into their programs of study, to the degree allowed within elective hours. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills. See
