Students completing this proposed pathway may choose to major within one of the following John Chambers College of Business and Economics: Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship and Innovation; Finance; General Business; Global Supply Chain Management; Hospitality & Tourism; Integrated Marketing Communication; Management; Management Information Systems; or Marketing; Organizational Leadership.

To be admitted to the Chambers College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. Students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C or better:

- ACCT 1211 & 1212
- ECON 2200 & 2201
- ENGL 1100 & 2367

- MATH 1131
- CSCI 1101
- STAT 1350

The following majors require ACCT 1212 (ACCT 202):

- Accounting
- Finance

- Global Supply Chain Management
- Management

Depending upon the student's choice of major, additional criteria for admissions must also be met:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACCT 1211 & ACCT 1212; minimum grade of C- in MATH 1131.
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECON 2200 and ECON 2201; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 1131.
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: minimum grade of D- in MATH 1131
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in ECON 2200 and ECON 2201; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 1131.
- General Business: minimum grade of D- in MATH 1131
- Global Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of B- in MATH 1131.
- Hospitality & Tourism: minimum grade of D- in MATH 1131
- Management: minimum grade of C- in MATH 1131.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of B- in MATH 1131
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MATH 1131
- Organizational Leadership: minimum grade of C- in MATH 1131.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
