Additional criteria for admissions must also be met for specific programs, see below course or equivalent course requirements:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACCT 101 & 102; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 175.
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECON 200 & 202; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 175.

- Global Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of B- in B MATH 175.
- Hospitality and Tourism Management: A grade of C- or higher in ACCT 101. Minimum grade of D- in MATH 175.
- Management: minimum grade of C- in MATH 175.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of B- in MATH 175.
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MATH 175.
- Organizational Leadership: minimum grade of C- in MATH 175.
