Students must have a C or better in SOC 155 (SOC 101 WVU) to be admitted into the Criminology program upon transferring to West Virginia University.

Although students will lack the ANTH 105 requirement standard for admission into the Criminology program, student who meet the above requirement will be admitted per this articulation agreement.

Students completing degrees from the WVU Eberly College of Arts and Sciences are encouraged to work with their advisors to integrate completion of an academic minor or minors into their programs of study. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills.
