*Students only need to complete MAT 225 (MATH 155). Students who place directly into Calculus will not need to complete MAT 120 (MATH 126 WVU).

Financial and Managerial Accounting courses that are transferred to WVU will meet the accounting requirements for the John Chambers College of Business and Economics.

Students will need to complete ENGL 102 prior to their first semester at WVU. Students can prepare to take this course either the summer between their first and second year or the summer their second and third year. Students must complete this course to be admitted to the major.

To be admitted to the John Chambers College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. To be directly admitted to their desired major, students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C- or better:

- ECO 105 & ECO 110
- MAT 225 & MAT 135
- ENG 105 & ENGL 102 (WVU)
- ACC 105 & ACC 220
- BCOR 121 (WVU)

Students completing this proposed pathway may choose to major within one of the following Chambers College of Business and Economics fields:

Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship and Innovation; Finance; General Business; Global Supply Chain Management; Hospitality & Tourism; Management; Management Information Systems; or Marketing; Organizational Leadership.

The recommended sequence of courses for the third and fourth years of study may include required major courses in the Junior year for some majors and only BCOR courses for other majors. Please refer to the College of Business and Economics website (be.wvu.edu) for recommended sequences of courses for each undergraduate major.

Certain degree pathways have additional requirements for admittance:

- Accounting requires: B- or higher in both ACC 105 & 220; D- or higher in MAT 225 (MATH 155 WVU)
- Economics requires: One B- or higher and one C- or higher in ECO 105 & 110; a grade of C- in MAT 225
- Finance requires: B- or higher in both ECO 105 & 110; a grade of C- in MAT 225
- General Business: Minimum of a D- grade of in MAT 225
- Global Supply Chain Management: a grade of C- in MAT 225
- Hospitality & Tourism: Minimum of a D- grade of in MAT 225
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: Minimum of a D- grade of in MAT 225
- Management: Minimum of a D- grade of in MAT 225
- Management Information System requires: Minimum of a C- grade of in MAT 225
- Marketing: Minimum of a D- grade of in MAT 225
- Organizational Leadership: Minimum of a D- grade of in MAT 225

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
