Although not directly equivalent to WVU's ACCT 201 and ACCT 202, New River's ACCT 201 and ACCT 202 will be accepted for the required Financial and Managerial Accounting requirements.

Students who have completed BUSN 130 (BTEC 106), BUSN 245 (BTEC 113) & BUSN 255 (BUSA 2TC) with a minimum grade of C- will have satisfied the requirement for BCOR 121.

To be admitted to the John Chambers College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. Students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C- or better:

- ACCT 201 & 202
- ECON 211 & 212
- ENGL 101 & 102

- MATH 109* & MATH 150 (WVU)
- STAT 211 (WVU)

Students completing the above articulated plan of study may choose to enroll in any of the following College of Business & Economics programs: Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship & Innovation; Finance; General Business; Global Supply Chain Management; Hospitality and Tourism Management; Management; Management Information Systems; Marketing; Organizational Leadership.

*Students only need to complete MATH 150 (WVU) for the Chambers College of Business and Economic. Students who need to start at a lower-level Math course (MATH 109 = MATH 126) will need to still complete the required MATH 150.

Additional criteria for admissions must also be met for specific programs, see below course or equivalent course requirements:

- Accounting: A grade of B- or higher in ACCT 201 & 202; A minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Economics: One B- or higher, and one C- or higher in ECON 211 & 212; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: minimum grade of D- in MATH 150
- Finance: A grade of B- or higher in ECON 211 & 212; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- General Business: minimum grade of D- in MATH 150.
- Global Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Hospitality and Tourism Management: minimum grade of D- in MATH 150.
- Management: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Organizational Leadership: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
